

DEAR POTENTIAL DIPLOMATS OF AFRICAN AMERICA,

INTO THIS KIND OF AFRICAN AMERICAN REPARATION, AS AN APPROPRIATE SYMBOL OF RECONCILIATION, WE MOVE THIS WAY.

To import relevant stimulation, in face of an indebted presence, about reparational necessities, with African America concerned, such is an emboldened bust, at a tortured past, from which there has been an adulteration of bastardized futures that were engineered by peculiar genetic molestation, and regarded an entire natural order of people as an unnatural-kind. The primal caveat is simple, that a specific property was requested and obliged, to African American

people, as much that independence is a formulaic conditional correspondence of an emancipative strategy—for commonsensical satisfaction, there are sound logistical and reasonable explanations, obviously, about the mutual relationship between freedom and independence—but the principle was betrayed by the halfhearted sentiment of the same forces who were bound to those agreements, with ours, factually; therefore addresses of African American currency, naturally, they must be imported; however, they must mangle the subjected economic return of the objective land, actually, as one kind of resourceful example, only; and such, this is a reality, which, has been rested, since, inside the palm of insanity.

Clearly, about this mission of diplomacy, that human dignity is the primary premise of African American intention, but the hollow words of mere inactivated prayers are empty and vain; and so, these statements are meant of inspirational transition, to the activated occupations of our facilities. African America and all affiliated traditions that have come to a culmination, now, arisen from slumber, out and away, from the silhouettes of which were comforted conversions of reality, there is this collective condition that must emote the particular physique of our intellectual sensory, against the African American oppositions. We are unimpeded by any attempted affronts, the bear of ourselves, to fore flames of a hearth, here, at which point friction has been conceived, between our fantasies and our lives; and, at the same point, at which, we must redefine the boundaries of our existent racio-ethnical humanity, proudly.

Surely, one thing is clear and another one is certain, that African America must pursue and persist the ambitional repair of our ethnic-brood, onto the end, if worthy of the considerable dignities of which are our claimed bounty. With those matters of which make up the equations of ponderance, the right thing to do, such is not always a matter of reason; but, however, and, as much that subjects are still measurable quantities, this movement of our beings has been engaged, a solvent African American decision, about the necessitated vestments that we must bear of burden and privilege, unitarily nested, in this way. Thus, a picturesque view, from the hind, a sight of orange sun-sky, rested upon and between the valley hilltops, implicative of honorable African American causative activities, conducive to the heritagenial kinships and associative networks that make up our prospective status-of-existence, if we so shall possess the formative kind of will, and that I believe, faithfully, this ability is within the grasps of my people.

What is more, to complete the point of address, this direction is true, only when the intent is pertinent to African American dignity and humanity, actually. There can be no disoriented conflations, about our identity, as much that we are a purposeful stock, essentially, in our intent; and the recognition of this posit is enormous upon our needs, that our body is one, but

our organs are many, and our voices are the result of circumstantial diversities that compile the African American traditions.

A CALL TO THE HONARABLE TEACHERS OF BLACK AND AFRICAN AMERICA, WE SUMMON YOUR ENDORSEMENT, THROUGH DELEGATION, INTO OUR INTERNATIONAL UNION!!! YOUR DELGATES ARE REQUESTED TO REGISTER OR ENDORSE PARTICIPANTS, WITH THE CAPE ON THE WEBSITE

Herein, forthwith, on this day of our gods, in the year Two Thousand Twenty-Four, we issue a plea of unity, to all the nations, traditions and peoples of Black America, whereby, there is presented, a reparational plan, designed for a governmental amalgamation of our vested interests. Our mean is toward the seizure of reparations, through resources, provisioned by particular agencies of the United States government and in legislation. In commencement, to this critical engagement of an international assembly, conventional to reparative addresses, our hands are sanitized, with the oil of Nat Turner; and in regard of the vital imperatives that are necessary actions, to ours, today, although, the spirit may accommodate a vibrancy, in eternal sway, but forever, is not the way of the flesh, anyway; and for the repair of our people, we will have no desires of contradiction, unconditionally, about any of our days, now. (THECCN.AGENCY).

This reparative mission does not aim to resolve into a simple monetary compensation, in the form of some kind of paycheck, competently; and such would represent a discounted valuation of life, projected upon the perpetuated generative centuries of captured and tortured souls of African American people. Rather concluded necessary—and our ambition is based on assessments of relevant temporal conditions, given critical attention about them—that of this problematic continuum, reflected in the harsh imbalances of resourceful access to economic opportunity, ethnic-volition and national prosperity, between our people and those foreign, there is the development of an independent African America; and such considered solvent, therefore, by which insight, id est., we call upon the voices of all our churches, mosques, temples, schools, shops, studios, rooms, centers, businesses, hospitals, residences, all and whatever other stations of African American possession, to stand ready for public and private service; a security, to our collective sovereignty, and through representative delegation, that they are heard together and do agree to adjoin the missions of their respective purposes, as one national body and under one united banner that shall be constituted, and beholden to descendent kinships of membership, this same common end. (THECCN.AGENCY).

This is an invite, to your congregation—and all our teachers of Black America, be they Ministers, Pastors, Imams, Rabbis, Professors, or any other orders of leadership—for a provision of delegates, by your submission; who shall take part, in formation and procession, for our Parliament Of The Divine, to represent the presence of your persuasion; an establishment, newfangled, where African Americans are authors of our own destinies, as an ethnicity. We are the United Nations Of African America, an establishment of Grand-Supreme Master Negus Anthony Ray Ivey Junior, in regards to the Royalty Of Ngome, year Two-Thousand Twenty-Four, honorably. This nation moves in formation of a Constitutional Democratic Monarchy, whereby the Republic is represented by the Grand Ngome Minister, in the Black Ngome, which casts consistency, about imported relative respects and authorities, from the Parliament Of Divinity, the Royalty Of Ngome and the Politico Of Ministry. The Parliament Of the Divine is one of the highest honors of the Republic, A Collective Delegation Of Leaders, willful of participation, and inclusive of all represented recognized doctrines of dogmatic principle, but majority order shall be given to labs for the Pillars Of Our Divine: Mohammad for Islam, Ben Ammi Ben-Israel for Hebrew, Noble Drew Ali for Science, and Jesus for Christianity. Respectively, back domain (Islamic), middle domains (Judaist & Moorish), front domain (Christian). Also, there shall be centered, between the Pillars Of Our Divine, Pools Of Our Origins which include the divine disciplines of Vodun, Dinka and Dogon, among others. (THECCN.AGENCY).

SPONSORS:

This is a requisite invitation, to the people of your Black and African American oriented organization, regarded our **Convention On The Constitution Of An United Nations Of African America**, which is a national event, for **Sponsorship Diplomats**, by your submission; who shall take part, through sponsorship, a <u>contributory duty of national service</u>, in the formation and procession of our founded secular nation, collective of African American, heritage. Individual *donors* are asked for a <u>minimum donation</u> and organizations are asked a <u>minimum sponsorship</u>; and with such, sponsors will have <u>advertisement options</u> on a website hosted online and in our *manual*; as well, each sponsor will receive an *honorary Identification Card*, from the **United Nations Of African America** and will be enshrined, forever, as founders of our establishment of this new world of African America.

Your organization is sought for sponsorship to help us, in our mission, to achieve appropriate reparational packages that shall <u>improve the conditional humanistic quality of life</u>, for African American people, as an ethnicity. In return, for your sponsorship, you will be enshrined into African American history, with an entry in our book. You will receive a slot on our website, under sponsors and your organization will also have an opportunity to be placed on our

promotional materials, as we conduct events. The sponsorship of your organization is a <u>give</u> <u>back to the community</u>, with this opportunity, in this way, such that <u>participants achieve a</u> <u>professional credential</u> that can be used for resumes and other credits, among other endeavors of pursuit.

We are seeking Black and African American organizations to help us, in our project to *sue* the United States for federal reparations on a national level. We know there are local reparations efforts, but reparations is just a word. Anyone can receive reparations, for some kind of harm inflicted upon them, in their own time; but this reparation is for a particular *population*, i.e. African Americans, particular *events of the past* that have been valued, and particular *principles of law*.

Sponsorships are vital, to this mission; and so, we ask for your sponsorship, in two ways:

- 1. Your individual referential endorsement or that of your organization, that will be assigned a unique code that individuals who participate in our **African American Extended Community**Service-Experiential Learning Program (ECSELP) will enter. Your organization will be imprinted onto the certification of completion, for the service-learning credential, along with our signature.
- 2. That you <u>purchase a minimum number of books</u>, for our book drive, to distribute yourself or gift back to us. However, we encourage you to choose a package, for your sponsorship. Individuals and organizations shall support our book drives and information sessions, and the ECSELP, with their sponsorships.

Sponsorships are facilitated by independent governance of African American traditions.

An individual or organization will receive <u>permanent entry</u> into the African American Constitutional Handbook, as a founding sponsor, (purchase 40+ copies); entry onto the <u>website</u> for 1-year (includes an allotment of social media posts), as a sponsor (purchase 50+ copies); a <u>vendor booth at our event</u>, in your local area (purchase 60+ copies), <u>live-event demonstration</u> of products and/or services (purchase 75+ copies) and a 5-12 sentence description or 2-5-minute <u>audio or video interview</u> (purchase 100+copies). 40+ books start around \$2000 – 100+ books (start around \$4000). 39 or less books can be purchased, at any time, however, only as a <u>contributive donation</u>, with no advertisement. THIS IS A PRIVATE RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT PROJECT, AND NO ACADEMIC CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN, BUT PARTICIPANTS WILL ACQUIRE A CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL CREDENTIAL, AFTER OFFICIAL COMPLETION OF THEIR 6/MONTH- 1-YEAR PARTICIPATION, WHEREIN THOSE WHO COMMIT TO 1-YEAR WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR LEAD ROLES, AN EARNED EXTRA CREDIT ON THEIR CREDENTIAL, AND RECEIVE PRIORITY CONSIDERATION FOR PERMANENT POSITIONS, AS THEY BECOME AVAILABLE. THERE IS MUCH OPPORTUNITY, FOR FUN, EXCITEMENT AND TRAVEL. The Assignment:

Travel to the eastern shores of the United States, live on-site, in field operations, for either <u>6/months or 1-year durations</u>, on a team, at an *Urban Encampment Facility* (*EUF*), with **all necessary provisional amenities provided** (*room, board, on-site-*

security, hygiene station trailers, storage space and other accommodations are included), and engage specialized activities of developmental frameworks, designated for constitutional address, that will concern processual legalities, about national African American reparative measures; where-at conclusion of the assignment, submit an exam and receive an official reference certification award, endorsed by the proud sponsors of this African American liberation and independence program.

Goals:

Gain *cultural service experience*, with <u>volunteer hours</u>, in the larger African American national community.

Enhance *competent advocacy management*, by <u>liberal research</u> of African American national economy.

Learn *receptive intervention techniques*, through <u>racioethnical workshops</u> and on-hand experiences.

Projected Start Date: Summer Session 2027

Location:

This project will take place, within the four state locales of **Delaware, South Carolina, Georgia, and Florida**. Each team will be assigned to a site, within one of these locations.

Qualifications:

This project is open for registration to *current students* and *alumni* of *High School*, *Community College*, *University*, *Graduate School*, and to *Professionals* of any industry.

Registration:

Registration is open now, and an interested participant will register with the Extended Community Service Experiential Learning Program, through registration with the CAPE on the website, pay the registration fee and take the optional exam. **Students whom take the optional exam will receive priority consideration, for leadership roles**.

We look to pool, from the first 20 participants of the first 250 registrations, who will be the first roll of volunteers, in this project; although, for others who continue to become

registered and stay updated with the project, are eligible for selection, at any later time, for participation.

Participants will need a code, in order to receive the basic rate of registration into the program which is \$12.50 and donation supplication of \$1.50/mo until the participation is initiated in the program, which holds their place in the project. Students will have a particular code and receive a discount to \$3 and non-referred people (those without a code) will be obligated to pay a \$250 sign up fee for the program.

Assigned Participation Fees for the 1-year:

Students that receive financial aid from an academic institution:

\$5400 (with referential sponsor - who should sign agreement with our project to be accountable for no-more-than up-to the remainder of balance that is not paid by participants, divided by 12-months, for an appropriate amount per month). Must remained enrolled, in their academy.

\$6600 (without referential sponsor). Must remain enrolled, in their academy.

Students that do not receive financial aid from an academic institution:

\$9000 (with referential sponsor - who should sign agreement with our project to be accountable for no-more-than up-to the remainder of balance that is not paid by the participant, divided by 12-months, for an appropriate amount per month).

\$108000 (without referential sponsor).

Participants will pay their fee per 6months, whether they choose the 6month or the 1year registration option, at the commencement of the infield portion of this project. Divide the fees by (.5), for a 6/Month registration. Participants can opt to cover the full 1-year in-full payment, for a 20% discount. Participants will be provisioned 2 weeks free time, for a 6/month dedication, which can be exhausted at whim of the participant, to a per day rate, except for the first 2 weeks of arrival; and for 1-Year, five weeks free time. There is an additional 2 weeks of approved sick time, in the event of an emergency or illness.

Additional Requirements:

No matter the fee assignment, participants must provide proof of Black or African American heritage, through two forms: an official birth certificate and valid state

identification card; must have valid medical insurance; must write and submit a 250-500 word statement of purpose; must submit a signature of endorsement, from faculty or staff of an accredited academic institution or other recognized community organization, on our form. Students who receive financial aid must remain enrolled, in at least part-time units, for each 6-month commitment in the program, the equivalent of one full quarter or semester, while in-field participation, which should total 2 sessions minimum in 1year; through an accredited academic institution, the enrollment must be online, work-study or some equivalent that will allow the participant to be away from campus, and provisions will be made for enrolled students to study and to complete the associated course assignments.

CAPE:

Would you like to be eligible, for qualification of African American reparations benefits? Whether you are full-blooded, part-blooded or non-blooded Black or African American, there is a role that you can play. Sign up for the CAPE, take the optional exam, and after the program has been completed, you will receive a certificate of reference. The more certificates that we generate, for reparational packages, through volunteers, in our registration drive, it is better, for us, because those records will represent endorsement of this now united Republic, and a solidification of our represented people.

Registrants who volunteer, with an *United Nations Of African America (UNAA)*, through the *Assurance Agency Of Militation (AAM)* and the *Community AllDES Programmatic Exam (CAPE)*, will receive a *Certificate of Entry (CE)* that would give notice of evaluated competency and skill development, in successful completion. The certificate allows all members to establish and maintain more fluency, in African American resourced community networks, as well. Recipients of this certification are eligible, to qualify, for recognized African American Diplomatic Status, through the *Corps Of Nationality (CN)*. Registrants may take the CAPE or submit a *National Development Duty (NDD)* of \$40,000 or volunteer full-time active duty (must be qualified, for available roles), to The United Nations Of African America. For high school and community college level student volunteers, they can supplement college/University applications, for interested academies or other African American oriented clubs, as a noted reference; University students, likewise, for supplementation of graduate school student or professional level volunteer applications of sorts, as utility, for interested schools or other African American associative organizational reference.

The certificate note is embedded with a unique processual code, for authenticated identification purposes.

The <u>CAPE</u> is endorsed by the qualified affiliates of an UNAA.





Do you remember the Black Political Convention of 1972?
There was a Declaration of Independence, but no constitution, nor did our actions move towards such a direction.

The system has taught you integration, for African Americans which makes you an integrant, actually. Now history is something; a challenge to keep report, not just for record, but for analysis. Actually, when we have these of our emigration, inter alia: Independent Courts, Independent Banks, Independent Schools etc.; National Law, National Currency, National Language, etc.. Thus, a sovereign United Nations Of African

American republic, then-andthere is found reparations!

LISTEN UP, MY FELLOW BLACKS AND AFRICAN AMERICANS!

For our kind, reparations are about the dignity of humanity, not about the rights of civility.

Correctly, we come, not for trifles over beliefs, about the internal systems that racialize the individual communities of our people; but to amalgamate a government of delegates, representative of our ethnical whole of people, from around the United States; because, anyway, if there is a mutual oppressor, such does not hold the same views that we do, beholden the doctrines regarded of ourselves; and so, let us not become buried, under the rubble of rhetoric, to be convinced, after-all, that we are unworthy of the indebted privileges and obligations owed us; that is, where totality concerns African American humane repair, not mere civil rights.

However, clearly, a complete catcher term, id est, whether African American, Black American, Black Native American, Black Moorish, Hebrew Israelite, Black Muslim, Black Protestant or any other of the like, you are still eligible, as a potential full-blooded or part-blooded member-citizen of the United Nations Of African America. Bring your religions; bring your skills; bring your aspirations. Uncle Skeeter says, he wants you, courtesy of the Grand-Supreme Master Negus Anthony R. Ivey, Jr. and an United Nations Of African America (UNAA).

DO YOU QUALIFY AS A FULL-BLOODED AFRICAN AMERICAN, FOR UNAA NATIONAL REGISTRATION PURPOSES?

1. African Americans shall be considered descendants of and represent the Black people of all our African American Nations, the African Aboriginals, Freedmen, Refugees, and all our lineages around the planet earth and the whole universe that are now or that ever were before Black Slaves, Negroes or Freedmen of the North, Central, South Americas and the Caribbean Islands, effective of those chattel laws imposed onto our kidnapped personas; but not whom be of those non-citizen immigrants and residents of Black or African descent that are of our contemporary brethren, although, in the United States; and we are national affiliates, but not those counted amongst our brethren within those Five Civilized Tribes of Native America; still included, here, and to be accounted amongst us, they are also, those other Freedmen who are too Native American Freedmen in ethnicity, but they are unaccounted amongst our Freedmen brethren of the Five Civilized Tribes, et. al., to consider the eligibility of an affiliated Member-Citizen.

a. African Americans that satisfy Section One of this Article must also have been registered Black or African American or the like, in North, Central, South America or the Caribbean Islands, in the year Two Thousand Twenty, or a lineal descendent of the same, based on official business to government documentation, personal tax filing status, any kind of United States (I)Nine documentation sets, or other acceptable documents of the like that may be available, such shall suffice proof of race and ethnicity status; and an affiliate must have one parent, up to a Grandparent, at least, that was also registered in the United States Of America as African American between the years of Two Thousand Ten and Sixteen Hundred Twenty.

i. The designation of 'other' or 'mixed' or any other vague term of the like, alone, they do not suffice, but for documentation that declares explicit, in expression that one is 'Black' or 'African American'.
